Member, Michael Christenson of Pennsylvania wants to warn all farriers: **Beware of Fly Sprays**

When you use a commercial fly spray, or pesticide, do you wear long sleeves, gloves and a mask? You might want to think about what you're using on your horse next time **you handle it as a farrier.**

We called **BWFA Master Farrier Michael Christensen** from Linesville, PA to see if his farrier tools had sold yet, which is still listed in the eNewsletter. While on the phone he talked about how he had recently been diagnosed with **T Cell Lymphoma**. The Specialists told him he had gotten it from using fly spray and not protecting himself from the spray. His specialist said that he should have worn long sleeves and afterwards changed his shirt and washed his hands. Now he has to have a scan every 90 days and surgery is the only resort in removing it. Needless to say, he was shocked. He loved shoeing. So... this combined with the past vehicle accident he had, he was forced to retire. So now he fishes!

Quick Fly Spray

18 oz white vinegar

2 Tbsp dish washing soap.

Mix in a 20 oz spray bottle and shake gently until well blended. You may add water to dilute. Spray liberally on your horse.







The office shipped the tools and a check in 2013 and Max returned this email back to us.....


